#### Movement -


Spring Movement activities – skip like a lamb, hop like a frog, curl up small and then grow up tall like a seed growing in the ground.

Go for a walk and find signs of spring – leaves coming onto the trees, flowers, little birds, warmer weather, longer evenings.


