So off went Henny-Penny and Cocky-Locky to tell the King the sky was falling, and, before long, they met Ducky-Daddles.

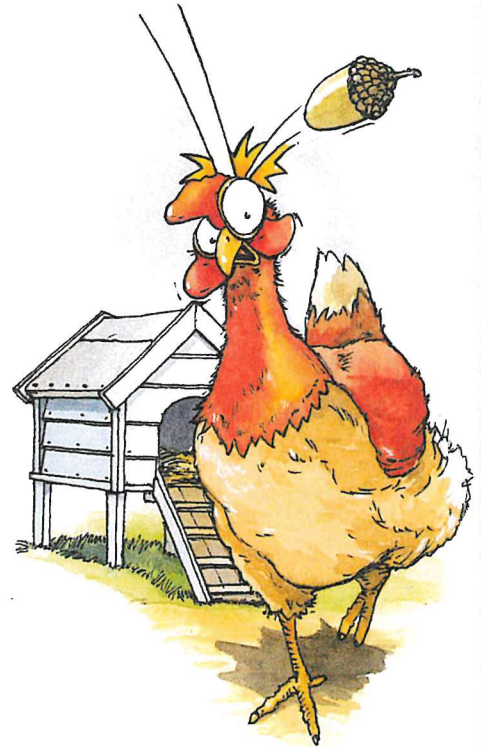
'Where are you going?' asked Ducky-Daddles.

'Can I come, too?' asked Ducky-Daddles.

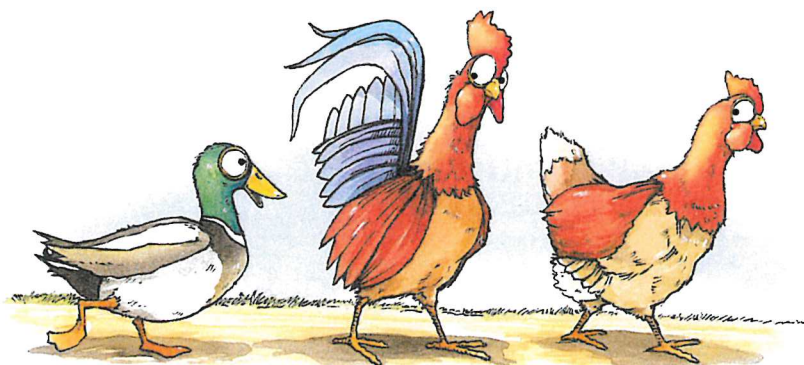
'Yes, do,' said Henny-Penny and Cocky-Locky.

So off went Henny-Penny, Cocky-Locky and Ducky-Daddles to tell the King the sky was falling and, before long, they met Goosey-Poosey ...



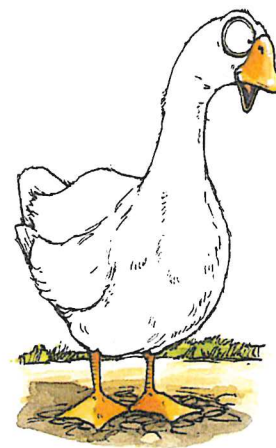
